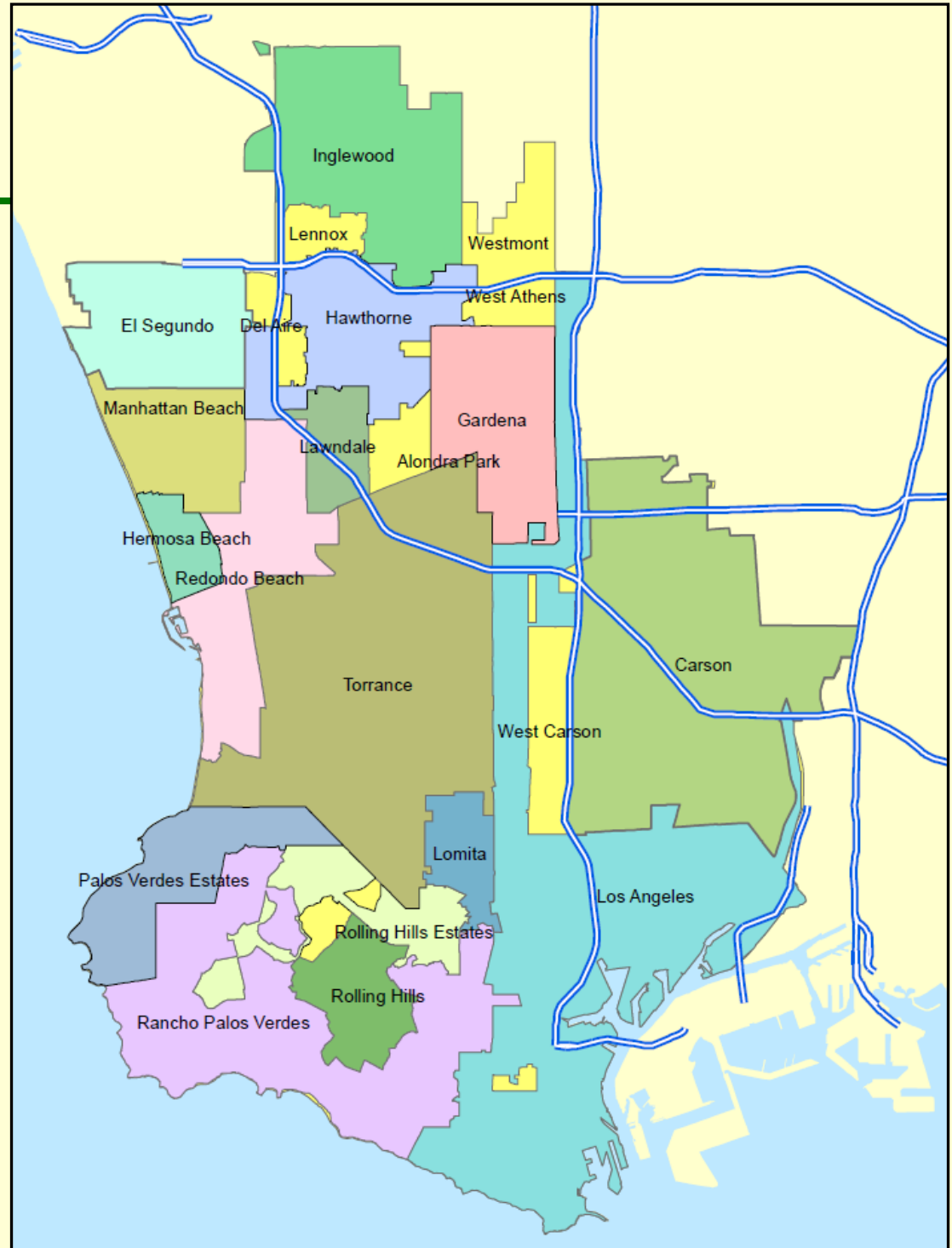

Transportation

- Measure R program
 - 5 projects completed
 - Nearly 55 projects in the pipeline to be completed by 2021

- South Bay Mobility Matrix for next Long Range Transportation Plan
 - Includes quality of life projects – ex. slow speed lanes & EV conversions

- Possible Future County Sales Tax

- I-110 Express Lane

- Harbor Gateway Transit Center



Conserving Resources

- Programs at SBESC
 - Finishing direct install for municipal facilities and faith based groups. Promoting direct install for the middle income group.
 - Installed energy management information systems in our cities
 - Provided Trainings and Workshops in English and Spanish

- Plug-In Electric Vehicle Readiness research focusing on multi-family dwellings
 - California Energy Grant application

- Climate Action Planning
 - Strategic Growth Council Grant

- Services for Seniors Working Group
 - Looking at better coordination of transportation services for seniors in the South Bay

- Economic Development Coordination
