At the May Steering Committee meeting, the rules for Public Comment at SBCCOG were reviewed.

It was agreed that the Public Comment Rules for SBCCOG meetings would be as follows:

- 1) Only for items not on the agenda
- 2) 3 minute time limit
- 3) Board members can only ask questions (through the chair) of the speaker for clarification
- 4) No audio visual (ex. Powerpoint) will be allowed but handouts can be distributed
