RE: Vacancy on the Steering Committee

At the June Board meeting, the Board elected 3 officers of the SBCCOG as well as 4 at large members to the Steering Committee. In order to be a member of the Steering Committee, the designee must be the delegate or alternate from their city.

Since the election in June, Manhattan Beach City Councilmember David Lesser has been replaced as one of his city's representatives to the SBCCOG. Therefore, Councilmember Lesser can no longer serve on the Steering Committee and has resigned.

At the July Steering Committee meeting, the vacancy was discussed. A geographical makeup of the Steering Committee members was also reviewed and it was determined that especially with Councilmember Lesser's resignation, the Beach Cities were underrepresented. Redondo Beach Councilmember Christian Horvath, who was present at the meeting, was asked his interest in serving and he was agreeable.

## **RECOMMENDATION:**

The Steering Committee recommends that the Board elect Redondo Beach Councilmember Christian Horvath to fill the vacant at large seat on the Steering Committee.
