Municipal Energy Savings

- 2015 Project Activity
 - 1,888,383 kWh savings underway. Will exceed goal by 10% if project incentives are paid by end of year.
 - **14,144 therms** savings already claimed. Have exceeded goal by 40%.
- Future Cost Savings Identified
 - 14M kWh and 28k therms savings per year
 - \$3M cost savings per year
 - 11k tons GHG reduced per year
 - \$2.5M cash incentives



SCE Direct Install Program


- FREE Equipment and Installation for Qualified Measures
 - High efficiency fluorescents, motion sensors, screw-in LEDs.
 - Work performed by SCE qualified contractors.
 - 2015 Program may offer new measures i.e., pool pump VFD, A/C controls.



Special Initiatives

- SCE Planning to Convert Utility-Owned Streetlights to LED.
- Some Cities are Pursuing the Purchase of Utility-Owned Streetlights.
- Supporting SCG Incentive Programs in LA District 15.
- SBCCOG Facilitating Energy Manager's Meetings for City Staff.
- Several Cities Participating in OBF Program Carson, Gardena, Hermosa Beach, Inglewood. Many more could qualify.
 - Cities can fund qualified energy efficiency projects (gas / electric) at zero interest and with no fees.
 - City will repay SCG or SCE in monthly installments added as a line item on the City's utility bill.
 - The loan is bill neutral.
 - Qualified projects must be eligible for incentives and payback in 10 years or less.

Gardena Street Light Project



Project Description:

Upgrade (241) City-owned Street Lights to LED

Project Timeline:

Construction Underway
Completed Q4 2015

Project Cost: \$142,820 (funding source – SCE OBF)

SCE Incentive: \$18,325

Annual Energy Savings:

189,610 kWh

Annual Energy Cost Savings: \$12,968

Simple Payback: 9.6 years (LED life – 15 to 20 years)

City's Out-of-Pocket

Costs: ~\$2,000
