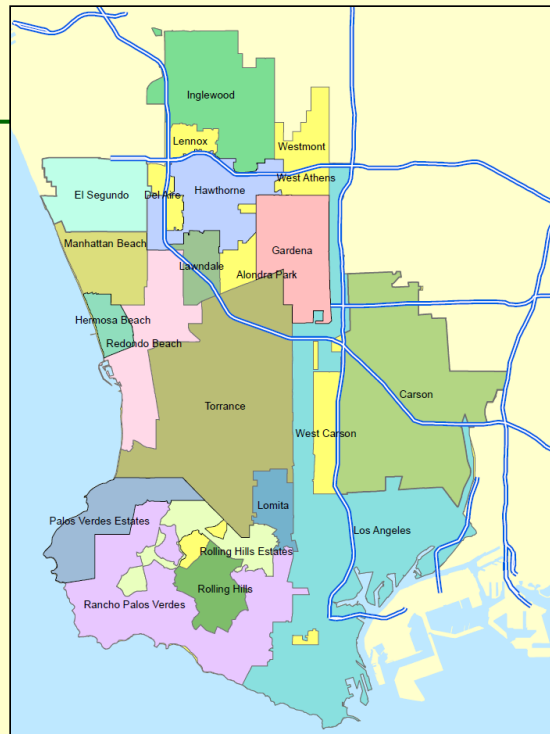

Update of South Bay Initiatives:

- Highlights since January





Homeless Services for the South Bay - Highlights

- Lack of housing remains a critical issue. Rapid re-housing vouchers were frozen in December!
- Home for Good Funders Collaborative (Measure H & United Way funds) implementation grant proposal update: Hermosa Beach, Manhattan Beach and Redondo Beach submitted an application for a homeless services coordinator and housing navigator and it was funded at a reduced amount. Two other cities applied but were not awarded funding.
- SBCCOG staff will be working with the County on a home sharing pilot project to bring it to the South Bay.
- The next Housing & Health Resources Fair is scheduled for May 29th in San Pedro. The SBCCOG has been successful in securing participation from the Public Defender Criminal Record Clearing Project Mobile Unit, the DMV Mobile Unit, & local water agencies.
- The 2019 Homeless Count numbers are expected to be released in late May/early June.
- Next meeting of the SBCCOG Homeless Services Task Force is scheduled for May 1st. It will focus on how the coordinated entry system works.

Connect 58 people to mental health	20 Referred to street-based mental health
Connect 30 people to substance abuse treatment	5 Referred to street-based substance use specialist
Connect 58 people to primary care	24 Referred to street-based primary care
Connect 58 people to mainstream benefits	49 Referred to CBEST, General Relief
Connect 130 people to interim housing	12 Linked to Interim Housing
Connect 65 people to permanent housing	3 Moved into a home, 6 additional
