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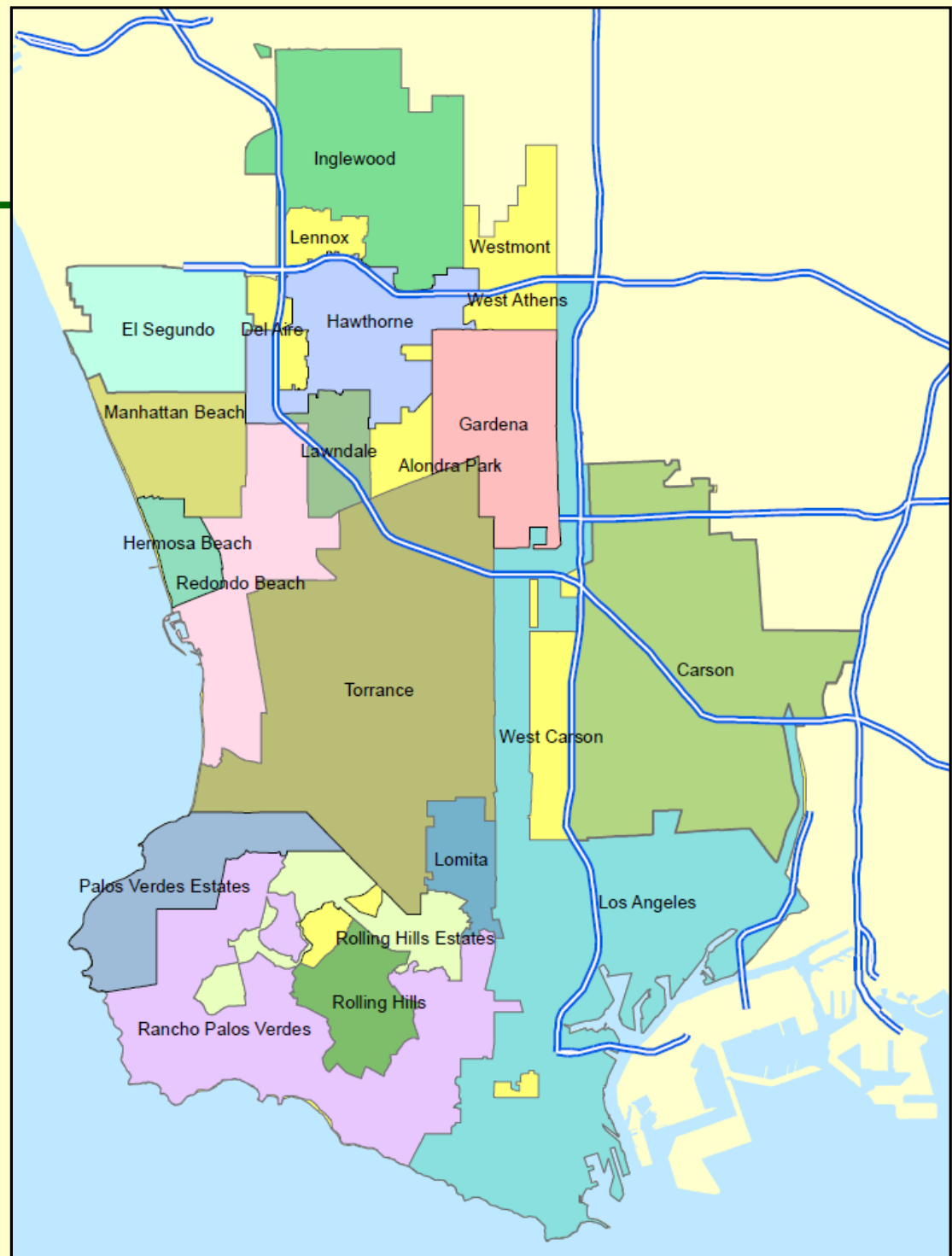

# South Bay

## Broadband Feasibility Study

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- Final draft study should be out this month – findings show potential for much better service at much lower cost
- Report to the Board in May
- Series of Brown Bag lunches to learn more about the technology and applications to start May 24
- Funded by So Bay Workforce Investment Board



# Homeless Services for the South Bay

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- Dedicated community outreach program specific to the South Bay provided by People Assisting the Homeless (PATH)
- Funded by Supervisors Hahn & Ridley-Thomas through June 30, 2017 – need to seek permanent funding
- Participating in the Measure H Revenue Planning Meetings; Board of Supervisors will vote on the funding recommendations from the committee on June 13
