

SECOND AMENDMENT TO PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT

This Second Amendment to PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT ("Second Amendment") is made and entered into as of December 12, 2016 by and between the South Bay Cities Council of Governments, a joint powers authority ("SBCCOG") and the Siembab Corporation ("Contractor").

RECITALS:

- A. The parties previously entered into Professional Services Agreement dated January 22, 2015 ("Agreement"), wherein the SBCCOG retained the services of Contractor to perform various tasks.
- B. The parties now desire to amend Task Order #1 (Exhibit A in the Agreement) in two ways:
- Extend the termination date for the Multi-Family Dwelling Unit Electric Vehicle Charging Station study funded by the CEC.
 - Increase the not to exceed budget to produce Climate Action Plans for the project funded by the Strategic Growth Council and Metro.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing, the Agreement is amended as follows:

1. Extend the contract termination date for the Multi-Family Dwelling contract funded by the CEC to December 31, 2016.
2. Increase the not to exceed budget amount for the Climate Action Planning project by \$100,000 from \$175,000 to \$275,000.

In all other respects, the Agreement as amended is hereby reaffirmed and in full force and effect.
