

**AMENDMENT TO MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING**

This amendment to the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is made as of June 30, 2021 by and between the South Bay Cities Council of Governments, a California joint powers authority ("SBCCOG") and the City of Redondo Beach ("City"), a chartered municipal corporation, (collectively, the "Parties").

**RECITALS**

- A. Parties entered into a Memorandum of Understanding as of October 6, 2020 wherein SBCCOG awarded the City \$245,287 of its Measure H Innovation Grant Funds to be used on the City's Enhanced Response Pilot Program.
- B. The Agreement expired on June 30, 2021 and the parties desire to extend the Term to December 31, 2021 with no increase in funding.
- C. SBCCOG Steering Committee ratified the extension of this Agreement at its August 9, 2021 meeting.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, in consideration of the foregoing, the Parties agree to amend the MOU as follows: The MOU is hereby amended by extending the Term to December 31, 2021 unless earlier terminated pursuant to the provisions of the MOU.

Except as modified above, all other provisions of the MOU remain in full force and effect.
