## WHO WE ARE

We are a broad coalition of veterans' organizations, affordable housing advocates, business and labor leaders, cities, environmental groups and many more committed to helping Californians have safe, affordable homes with the \$4 billion *Veterans and Affordable Housing Act* that will go before voters in November 2018.



## WHAT THE ACT DOES FOR CALIFORNIA VETERANS, STRUGGLING FAMILIES AND PEOPLE WITH DISABILITIES

- 🏠 Dedicates funding to help military veterans have a safe place to call home.
- 🏠 Provides stable housing for struggling families, people experiencing homelessness and individuals with disabilities.
- 🏠 Builds affordable homes for hardworking people like grocery clerks, nurse aides and teaching assistants. This helps people live in the communities where they work and serve, while still having money for basics like groceries and child care.
- 🏠 Tackles top priorities for Californians – building homes, creating jobs and boosting the economy. It's expected to create 137,000 jobs and pump \$23.4 billion into California's economy.

## WHY CALIFORNIANS NEED AFFORDABLE HOUSING

- 🏠 The housing crisis is crushing the 1 in 3 Californians who can't afford their rents.
- 🏠 Many people are spending more than 30% of their incomes and some as much as 50% of their incomes on housing.
- 🏠 The gap is so wide between what Californians earn and the cost of rent that families are separated by excruciating commutes because they can't afford to live in the cities where they work.
- 🏠 The human devastation of the housing crisis and homelessness is taking hold in more Californians' lives. California has the largest population of unsheltered veterans in the nation. Families pushed to the brink live in their cars or double and even triple up in overcrowded housing as they try to maintain their jobs and ensure their children go to school.

## FILLING POTHoles AND REPAVING ROADS

- Repaving **205 miles** of **Highway 1** from the Los Angeles/Orange County line to the City of Santa Monica, along Pacific Coast Highway, Sepulveda Blvd., and Lincoln Blvd.
- **112 miles** of pavement improvements and repairs to guardrails and signage on **I-5**
- **104 miles** of pavement improvements on **I-605** from the Los Angeles/Orange County line to Telegraph Rd
- Pavement preservation project on **48 lane miles** and improve ramps on **I-10** from the **San Bernardino/Los Angeles County** line to I-10/I-15 Separation in San Bernardino County
- Resurface more than **5 miles** of **onramps and offramps** along **SR 91** near Buena Park
- **Resurface** nearly 7 miles of **I-5** between **I-605** and Washington Blvd. in the Los Angeles area
- Repair and resurface various sections of **SR 57**, north of the Los Angeles/Orange County Line and **SR 60** in **Diamond Bar**
- **Resurface Orange Grove Blvd** in **Pasadena**
- **Resurface Hawthorne Blvd.**; Silver Spur; Deerhill Dr., Harbor Sight Dr., Spinning Wheel Lane and Sweetgrass Dr. in **Rolling Hills Estates**
- **Repave 21 streets** in **City of Norwalk**



## TRAFFIC CONGESTION RELIEF

- **Construct an additional lane on Arrow Highway off-ramp** and **39.5 lane miles** on **I-605** from I-10 to I-210 (south of Huntington Drive) in Los Angeles
- Improve signal and pavement on **40 miles** on **I-605** from **I-10** to **I-210**
- Install **76 traffic management systems** on **I-110** from I-405 to the southern terminus in San Pedro to monitor travel time
- **Ramp metering** repairs and vehicle detection updates on **I-10** at various locations
- Upgrade **traffic monitoring elements** on **I-5** at **I-605**; **I-405** at **I-105**; **I-10** at **I-5/I-10** and **I-605** at **I-10**

# Examples of Projects Underway in Los Angeles County that could be

**AT RISK**



## BRIDGES

- Repair **San Gabriel River Bridge** on I-405
- Repair **northbound I-405 to southbound I-605 Connector** in Los Angeles County
- **Lower roadway or replace 10 bridges** to meet vertical clearance or truck load capacity standards on I-5 in **Glendale**
- Improve vertical clearance for **trucks to improve freight movement** on **SR 60** at Hacienda Boulevard Undercrossing, Stemson Avenue Undercrossing, Azusa Avenue Overcrossing and Fullerton Road Undercrossing



## ROAD SAFETY

- **I-605/SR 91 interchange improvements** to address safety and congestion in area heavily impacted by freight
- **Visibility and safety improvements** by **restriping** traffic lanes and crosswalks in **Old Town Monrovia**
- **Upgrade curb ramps and guardrails** on **SR 1-Pacific Coast Highway**



## PEDESTRIAN SAFETY

- Pedestrian improvements along **Pico Boulevard** to improve safety along one of the **City of Santa Monica's** highest collision areas and improve connectivity
- **Sidewalk improvements** to include new pedestrian ramps for improved disabled access in **Burbank**
- **Shoulder safety improvements** on **Mulholland Highway** and providing a pedestrian pathway in **Calabasas**
- Improvements at 5 elementary schools to include closing gaps between existing sidewalks, installation of ADA ramps and new striping and signage for safer street crossings in **Lancaster**



## PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION

- **Signal and track modernization** to improve speed and reliability for **Metrolink** and **Amtrak** trains arriving and departing **Los Angeles Union Station**
- **Airport Metro Connector** 96th Street Transit Station connecting LAX to regional transit
- Expanded bus routes, increased capacity and extensions to include Gold Line to **Montclair** and Green Line to **Torrance** for **Metro**
- Maintenance on **56 Clean Natural Gas** transit buses in **Culver City**
- Replace 45 old buses with all new **electric buses** for **Foothill Transit**
- **Replace 16 bus stop shelters** in **South Whittier** and add safety improvements
