Reducing Emissions

- > More electric buses and expanded bus routes for Cities of Gardena, Redondo Beach and Torrance
- > New bike and pedestrian path along the Dominguez Channel in Carson
- > New safety and highway improvements for the I-405 Crenshaw Bl interchange

Safer Roads

Filling More Potholes

- Funding for cities and unincorporated areas to:
- > Repair potholes and sidewalks
 - > Install upgraded traffic signals and pedestrian lights
 - > Repave local streets
 - > Improve pedestrian and bike safety, and upgrade bus shelters

Smoother Commutes

- > Installing technology upgrades to monitor and manage traffic throughout Los Angeles
- > Upgrading safety features, and repaving and re-striping SR-1 through the South Bay
- > Funding for the Freeway Service Patrol to relieve congestion on highways

Stretching your Measure M Dollars

- > Extending the Metro Green Line from Redondo Beach to the new Regional Transit Center in Torrance
- > Building the 96th Street Airport Metro Connector Transit Station as a new hub for LAX and Metro's Crenshaw/LAX and Green Line
- > Operational and station improvements on the Metrolink commuter rail system
