Bills Signed Into Law Since January

1. *California Desert Protection and Recreation Act*
2. *Sacramento-San Joaquin Delta National Heritage Area Act*
3. *Santa Ana Wash Plan Land Exchange Act*
4. *Contra Costa Canal Transfer Act*
5. *Breast Density and Mammography Reporting Act*

Selected Bills Introduced this Congress

Fighting Homelessness through Services and Housing Act (S. 923):

Increases federal resources to battle homelessness. Specifically, the bill authorizes \$750 million in grants annually for the next five years for local governments to combat homelessness.

Ensuring Safe Housing for Our Military Act (S. 703):

Addresses health and safety in privatized military housing after a recent Reuters investigation found hazardous living conditions in privatized military housing throughout the United States.

Agricultural Worker Program Act of 2019 (S. 175):

Allows farmworkers who have worked in agriculture for at least 100 days in the past two years to earn a "blue card" to legally work in the United States and ultimately become eligible for a Green Card.

Personal Care Products Safety Act (S. 726):

Gives FDA new tools to regulate cosmetics products, including requiring regular safety evaluations of ingredients, registration by companies, maintenance of safety records, and mandatory recall authority for contaminated products.

Keep Families Together Act (S. 3036):

Prohibits the separation of families at the border.

Assault Weapons Ban of 2019 (S. 66):

This bill makes it a crime to knowingly import, sell, manufacture, transfer, or possess a semiautomatic assault weapon or large capacity magazine.
