

# **SBCCOG Meeting 03/03/2021**

## **1. Program Updates**

### **a. Recovery Rehousing/Recovery Bridge Housing**

- i. Caseload for this program is full and we are actively working to house folks from all over SPA 8 in this program who are at high risk for COVID-19.
- ii. We have housed a total of 8 folks since we started working this program about 2 months ago and are active in housing search with all of the rest.

### **b. Prevention**

- i. Continue to ensure folks are connected to any needed legal services, referrals to LA County, state and individual city Rental Assistance programs and assist where we can.

### **c. New Programs in SPA 8**

#### **i. Torrance Outreach/Housing Navigation**

1. On 2/1/21, Harbor Interfaith Services began working with the city of Torrance in an official capacity in that we have one outreach/housing navigator dedicated to the city of Torrance. Her name is Valerie Hernandez and she has been working with city staff, TPD and others to get to know those in need of services in the city and engage them in services with the end goal of permanent housing.

#### **ii. CD-15 City of LA**

1. Safe Parking Programs in San Pedro & Harbor Gateway for individuals experiencing vehicular homelessness in CD-15.
2. Opened 3/1/21 – no referral needed, clients can go straight there.
3. VOA is provider in San Pedro & WLCAC is provider in Harbor Gateway.

- iii. We recently led a **homeless service provider training** for anyone new to services in SPA 8 to ensure all staff and providers know who the SPA 8 leadership is and how to go about referring to various programs.

1. One on 2/23 for various provider
2. One on 2/25 for DMH providers.

- d. CES Director, Shari Weaver will provide updates on San Pedro Interim Housing, San Pedro ABH & Redondo Beach Pallet Shelter.
