1. Program Updates

a. Recovery Rehousing/Recovery Bridge Housing

- i. Caseload for this program is full and we are actively working to house folks from all over SPA 8 in this program who are at high risk for COVID-19.
- ii. We have 30 slots available and we have housed 19 of 30 slots with 6 pending applications. 63% placement rate.

b. Prevention

- i. Continue to ensure folks are connected to any needed legal services, referrals to LA County, state and individual city Rental Assistance programs and assist where we can.

c. Other Programs in SPA 8

i. Torrance Outreach/Housing Navigation

1. As a reminder - on 2/1/21, Harbor Interfaith Services began working with the city of Torrance in an official capacity in that we have one outreach/housing navigator dedicated to the city of Torrance. Her name is Valerie Hernandez and she has been working with city staff, TPD and others to get to know those in need of services in the city and engage them in services with the end goal of permanent housing.
2. Has housed 2 folks from Torrance thus far and has more in the works

ii. Beach Cities

1. Conducting Homelessness 101 Training for Beach Cities City Staff tomorrow, 5/6/2021 much like the one being conducted by the SBCCOG.
2. Outreach continues in the three Beach Cities and in collaboration with city staff, DMH, PD and other outreach teams.
