a. Recovery Rehousing/Recovery Bridge Housing

- i. Caseload for this program is full and we are actively working to house folks from all over SPA 8 in this program who are at high risk for COVID-19.
- ii. We have 30 slots available and we have housed 19 of 30 slots with 6 pending applications. 63% placement rate.

b. Prevention

- i. Continue to ensure folks are connected to any needed legal services, referrals to LA County, state and individual city Rental Assistance programs and assist where we can.
