



## **History of GLAC IRWMP**

- **2006** Plan developed with \$1.5 Million grant funds and adopted through collaboration of hundreds of agencies
- 2007 \$25 Million Proposition 50 grant funds awarded for 14 projects
- **2008** \$2 Million local funds collected to sustain integrated efforts and pay for grant applications
- **2009** Recognized by DWR as an IRWM Region through the State's Regional Acceptance Process
- **2010** \$1 Million awarded for Proposition 84 Planning grant funds to update Plan
- **2010** Collected another \$450K from local funds
- **2011** Awarded \$25.6 Million Proposition 84 Implementation grant funds for 13 projects. **\$53.1 Million**

May

- RMC to provide preliminary lists of projects and user accounts to Subregions
- Project updates to be provided to RMC by May 25

June

- Subregions to provide list of selected projects and active users to RMC
- RMC to import selected projects and user accounts into OPTI

July

- Subregions to solicit new projects
- Begin reviewing "on hold" projects

August

- Subregions to solicit new projects
- Subregions begin reviewing new projects
