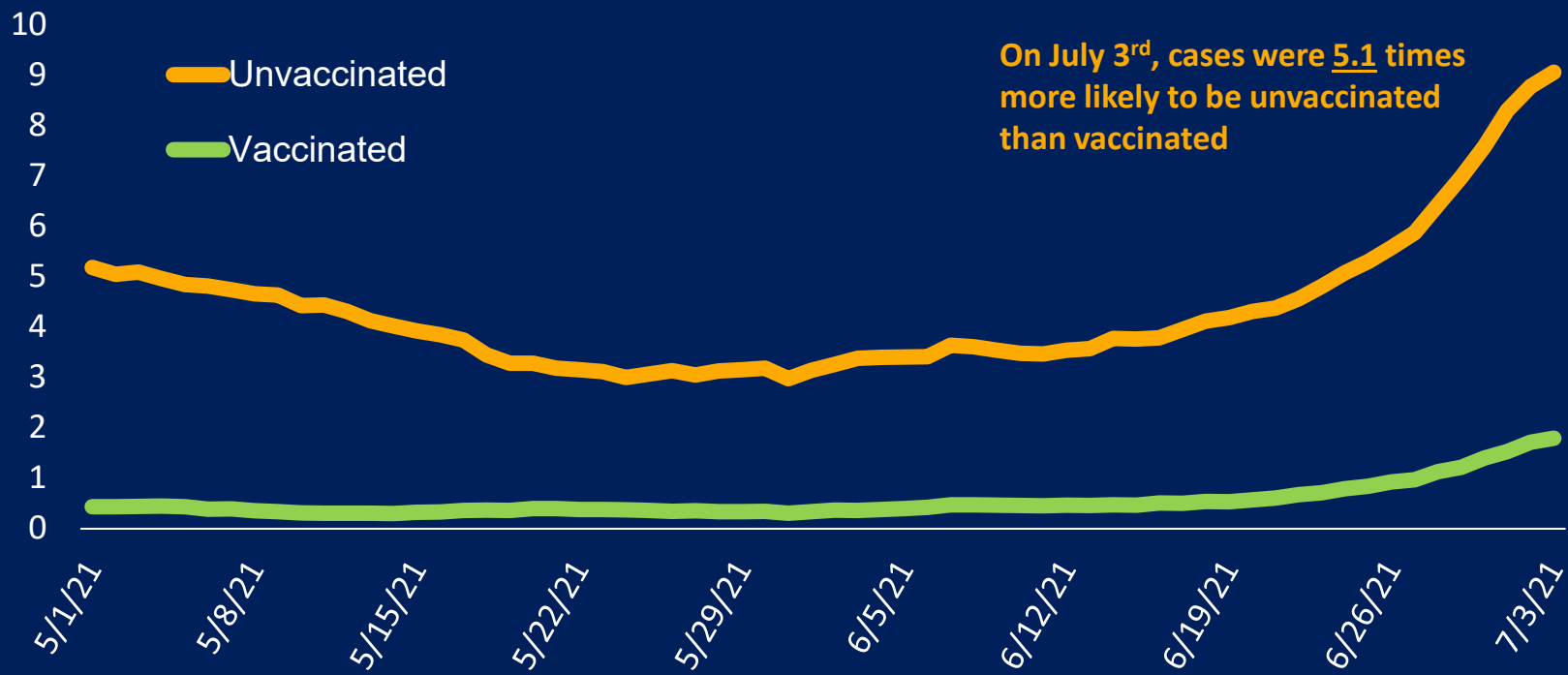




COVID-19

- Our county data suggest that community transmission of COVID-19 in LA County has very rapidly increased from Moderate to Substantial based on the trend in daily new cases of COVID-19.
- Test positivity rate is **4.8%**; the rate was **2.0%** two weeks ago
- Hospitalizations continue to increase daily, have almost doubled in the past two weeks

Unadjusted Case Rate per 100,000 for Los Angeles County by Vaccination Status May 1 – July 3, 2021

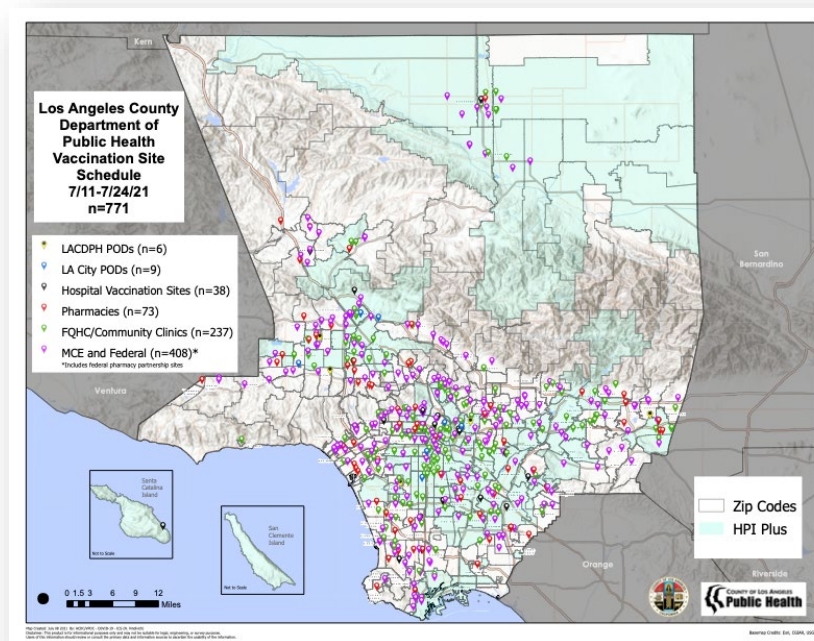




COVID-19

- Because of this rapid rise, and the increasing presence of the Delta variant of the virus, and the millions of people potentially at risk of infection, we implemented an order requiring masking indoors regardless of vaccination status
- We expect to keep this order in place until we begin to see improvements in our community transmission of COVID-19.
- Best collective action continues to be getting vaccinated if you are eligible and taking sensible precautions, especially for those who are not vaccinated
