# Crenshaw/LAX Project Connecting to the Green Line

**Five Green Line stations will be closed to connect and integrate with the Crenshaw LAX/Transit Project infrastructure.**

- **Duration:** 9pm, Friday, January 26, to 3am, Saturday, April 7, 2018
- **Closed stations:**
  - Aviation/LAX
  - Mariposa
  - El Segundo
  - Douglas
  - Redondo Beach
- All Bus Bays and Park & Rides will remain open.
- G-Shuttle bus will continue operating from the Aviation/LAX Station.

## Work Activity

- **Track:** Install tracks for trains to cross from the two existing Green Line tracks to the two Crenshaw/LAX tracks.
- **Signal:** Modify the Overhead Catenary System to provide power to the trains.
- **Vehicle:** Modify train control software and test on Green Line after incorporating Crenshaw/LAX elements overlapping the Green Line tracks.
- **Safety:** Test all the newly constructed items for safe operation once work has been completed.



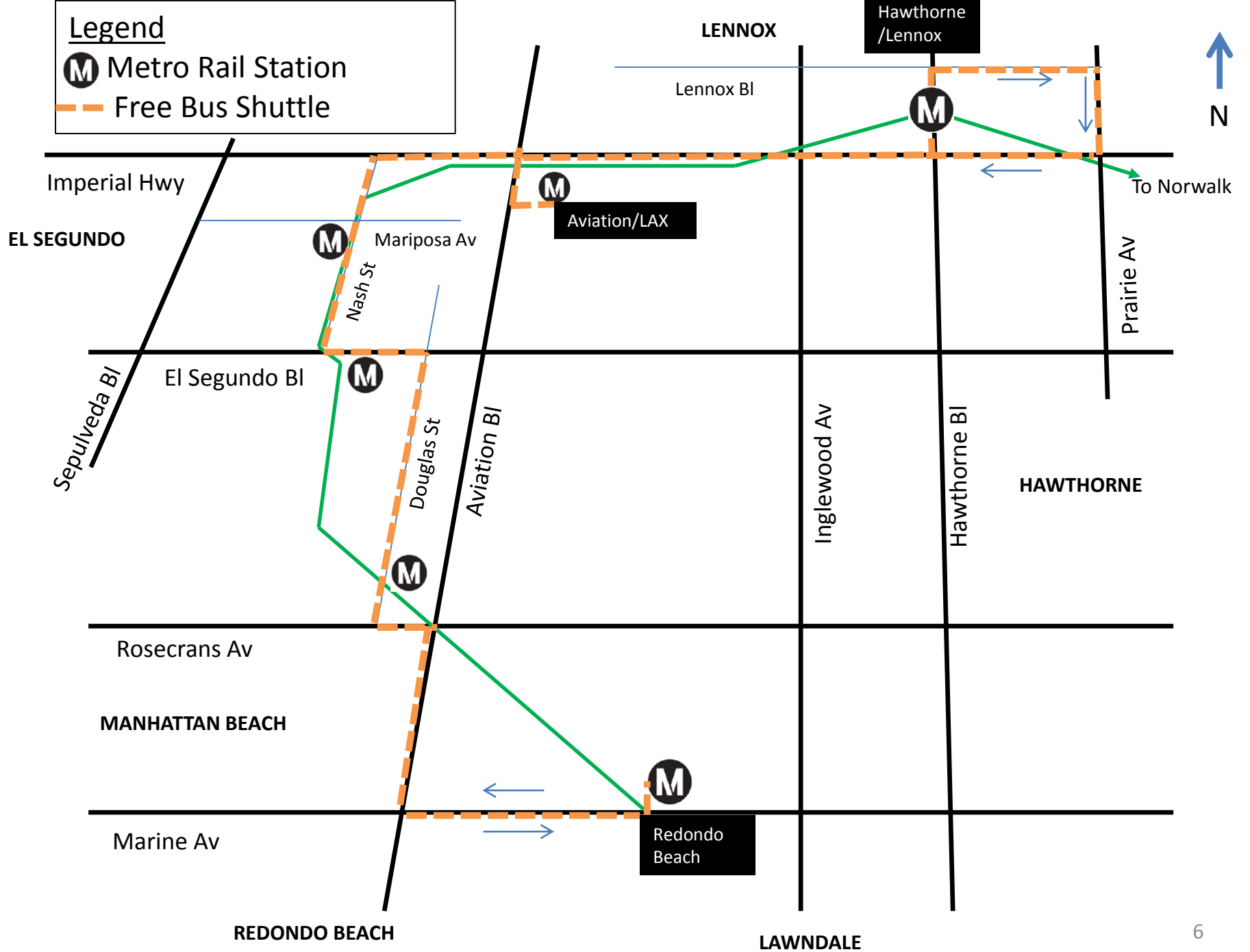
The guideway connecting the Crenshaw/LAX Line tracks to the junction of the Green Line.

## Continuing Service through Free Bus Shuttles

- Operating free Bus Shuttles between the Hawthorne/Lennox Station and Redondo Beach Station serving all closed stations to and from Redondo Beach.
- Free Bus Shuttles will operate at the same frequency as the Green Line trains.
- All Bus Bays and Park & Rides will remain open.
- G-Shuttle bus will continue operating from the Aviation/LAX Station.
- On the ground customer service representatives and Rail Ambassadors will assist customers for at least the first two weeks.
- Enhanced security.

# Public Outreach

## Public Outreach through April 7, 2018

- Post articles on agency blogs and alerts on social media channels
- Advertise on radio, online, print, and social media
- Distribute take-ones on all Metro rail lines and mailers within station areas
- Distribute fliers at Green Line stations, parking lots, and in surrounding neighborhoods via door-to-door distribution
- Notify third party applications, including Google/Apple Maps, Waze, and Next Bus
- Install bus stop and wayfinding signage, and on-board closure postings
- Provide Station and Operator announcements
- Provide on the ground customer service for at least the first two weeks
- Issue news releases and hold a Press Conference



## Metro Parking Pilot Program

Due to the Crenshaw/LAX Transit Project connecting to the Green Line, staff recommends delaying the implementation of the Parking Pilot Program until May 2018.

Green Line Stations included in the Parking Pilot Program along the Green Line include Aviation/LAX, Norwalk, Lakewood, and Crenshaw.
