



2022 Legislative Session - Final Report *Executive Summary*

Overview

During the 2022 legislative session, California Contract Cities Association took positions on 24 bills relating to local control, housing, public safety, energy, water, and mental health.

To date, CCCA's key 2022 legislative wins include:

→ AB 1886 - Public works: definition.

Authored by Asm. Jim Cooper, this bill required street sweeping employees to be paid prevailing wages. This unfunded mandate would have impacted street sweeping services and budgets to many of our member cities.

CCCA quickly mobilized to advocate against the bill in August and effectively gathered enough opposition to bring the legislation to a halt.

→ SB 930 - Alcoholic beverages: hours of sale.

Authored by Senator Scott Wiener, this bill required the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control to conduct a pilot program that issues additional hours licenses to restaurants, bars, nightclubs, and other on-sale licensees. These licenses would have permitted businesses to serve and sell alcoholic beverages until 4:00 AM, rather than 2:00 AM, in cities that include Cathedral City, Coachella, Fresno, Oakland, Palm Springs, and West Hollywood, and the City and County of San Francisco.

CCCA opposed the bill alongside other public safety stakeholders such as the California Association of Highway Patrolmen. The bill died on the Assembly floor in August.

→ AB 2000 - Motor vehicle speed contests and exhibitions of speed: off street parking facilities.

Authored by Assemblymember Jesse Gabriel, this bill outlaws motor vehicle speed contests and exhibitions of speed in off-street parking facilities.

During this year's legislative cycle CCCA consistently advocated for stronger penalties on crimes related to street racing, takeovers, and sideshows, as curbing the illegal activity is a key priority for many of our member cities. CCCA held a press conference addressing the issue in front of the Capitol in March, and



later submitted a letter in support of this specific legislation. The bill was enrolled in August.
