



Third Amendment to Independent Contractor Agreement

This Second Amendment is the to the independent Contractor Agreement made between the South Bay Cities Council of Governments (SBCCOG) (Client), with a principal place of business at 2355 Crenshaw Boulevard, Suite 125, Torrance, CA 90501, and Jon Rodman (Contractor), 5510 Laurette Street, Torrance, CA 90503.

RECITALS:

- A. The parties previously entered into Professional Services Agreement dated October 28, 2021 ("Agreement"), wherein the SBCCOG retained the services of Contractor to perform various tasks at a rate of \$32 per hour.
- B. The parties amended the Agreement June 30, 2022 to increase the budget by \$1,000 for a total of \$24,040 and add new GIS tasks in support of Measure R/Measure M programs.
- C. The parties now desire to add Exhibit D and extend the Term through June 30, 2024 to include additional tasks providing general GIS services in support of programs, with no increase in the total contract amount.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing, the Agreement is amended as follows: The Agreement is hereby amended by extending the Term to June 30, 2024 and adding Exhibit D attached.

In all other respects, the Agreement as amended is hereby reaffirmed and in full force and effect.
