

**SECOND AMENDMENT TO PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT**

This Second Amendment to PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT ("Second Amendment") is made and entered into as of June 22, 2023, by and between the South Bay Cities Council of Governments, a joint powers authority ("SBCCOG") and the Siembab Corporation ("Contractor").

**RECITALS:**

A. The parties previously entered into a Professional Services Agreement for the period of June 24, 2021, to June 30, 2024 ("Agreement"), wherein the SBCCOG retained the services of Contractor to perform various tasks for at total amount of \$60,000.

B. The parties amended the contract June 23, 2022, to add additional funds and scope for work order #2 for South Bay Fiber Network Applications Development Phase 2 in the amount of \$25,000 (revised total contract \$85,000).

C. The parties now desire to add additional funds and scope for Task Order #4 (Exhibit D) in the amount of \$50,000 (total contract amount \$135,000) for work on digital equity and access projects (includes LATA grant) and serving as technical advisor for various projects. In no event shall the total compensation -exceed the revised total amount designated for the task.

**NOW THEREFORE**, in consideration of the foregoing, the Agreement is amended as follows:

1. Exhibit D – Add Task Order #4 with budget not to exceed \$50,000

In all other respects, the Agreement as amended is hereby reaffirmed and in full force and effect.

## Exhibit D

In no event shall the total compensation exceed the amount designated for the tasks described below:

1. \$25,000 - Digital equity and access projects (includes LATA grant) technical assistance including reviewing program deliverables, overseeing program implementation, setting and monitoring schedule, and conducting other tasks as assigned.
2. \$25,000 - Technical advisor for land use and transportation projects including attending meetings and seminars, drafting proposals, commenting on work products, making presentations, and advising on implementation strategies.
