## UPCOMING ACCELERATING ELECTRIC VEHICLE ADOPTION WITH CURB MANAGEMENT WORKSHOP - AUG. 10

[Register here](#) to join us at the Accelerating Electric Vehicle Adoption with Curb Management Workshop on **Thursday, Aug. 10**. The workshop will highlight progress and findings from a Department of Energy (DOE) funded project, led by the Los Angeles Cleantech Incubator (LACI) in partnership with SCAG's Clean Cities Coalition.

This pilot study evaluates curb management in Pittsburgh, Pa., and Santa Monica and Los Angeles, Calif. The project is sponsored by the DOE's Vehicle Technology Office and aims to test strategies that will bolster electric vehicle adoption for last mile delivery, reducing air pollution in disadvantaged communities and environmental justice areas, and increasing productivity at the curb. The pilot also serves as a cleantech demonstration opportunity for automated curb management solutions utilizing automated license plate recognition technology.

Attendees will have the opportunity to learn more about the project, LACI's program and its community pilots. In addition, they will learn about and gain early access to curb management tools and policy guidance. This is a great opportunity to connect with other cities working to accelerate electric vehicle adoption, improve curb management and increase efficiency in last mile delivery.
