

THIRD AMENDMENT TO PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT

This Third Amendment to PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT ("Third Amendment") is made and entered into as of August 24, 2023 by and between the South Bay Cities Council of Governments, a joint powers authority ("SBCCOG") and the Siembab Corporation ("Contractor").

RECITALS:

A. The parties previously entered into Professional Services Agreement dated June 24, 2021 ("Agreement"), wherein the SBCCOG retained the services of Contractor to perform various tasks. This Agreement extends to June 30, 2024.

B. The parties now desire to add additional funds to Task Order #3 (Exhibit C) in an amount not to exceed \$25,000 for work on the Regional Early Action Program projects funded through the Southern California Association of Governments. All compensation continues to be funded through grants received and in no event shall exceed the revised total amount designated for the task.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing, the Agreement is amended as follows:

1. Exhibit C – Add funding to Task Order #3 not to exceed \$25,000

In all other respects, the Agreement as amended is hereby reaffirmed and in full force and effect.

Exhibit C – Task Order #3

All compensation will be funded through grants received and in no event shall exceed the total amount designated for the tasks described.

The South Bay Cities Council of Governments (SBCCOG) will be receiving funding from SCAG under the Regional Early Action Program. The Siembab Corporation will be the Project Manager for this program.

Funding under this task order will come from the SCAG Regional Early Action Program. Additional compensation for Siembab Corporation shall not exceed \$25,000.
