1. **Interim Housing (Shelter) Updates 7/1/2022-06/30/2023**
  - i. San Pedro Interim Housing – 14 vacancies / 8 Permanent housing placements
  - ii. San Pedro ABH –6 vacancies / 11 Permanent housing placements.
  - iii. Redondo Beach Pallet Shelter – No vacancies / 9 Permanent housing placements
  - iv. Torrance Pallet Shelter – No vacancies / 3 Permanent Housing Placements / 1 to medical higher level of care.

5. **CES Success Stories**

**Deric – 35 year old, homeless since 2007, and after 4 months at 3290 his homelessness ended on November 29<sup>th</sup>. He is now a tenant at Westhaven Permanent Supportive Housing. Deric reported that this is the first apartment of his own, is cooking and eating healthier and will be enrolling next semester at South West College, which is right across the street from his new home.**

**Cindy – 62 year old, homeless since 2017 after having a stroke. She lost her employment, then her apt. & was sleeping in her car at Columbia Park. The stroke left her permanently disabled, but it did not diminish her spirit. Cindy's homelessness ended after 5 months at 3290 on December 16<sup>th</sup>. The additional blessing is that her 37 year old daughter, whom she has not seen much since becoming homeless can now visit her at her new home.**
